Subject: Waste Tile Transport and Recycling Proposal

Hi Lyn,

Firstly I would to take the opportunity to say thank you for taking the time to meet with me this morning.

To clarify our discussion we can organise the disposal and recycling of clean tiles into facilities on the north and south of Brisbane without a problem. The tiles can be crushed into aggregates and other fine particles for various applications including but not limited to drainage and other civil engineering products. This means that tiles, along with concrete and brick are virtually 100% recyclable.

We discussed the challenges of logistics focusing on major projects and taking into consideration that major construction companies engaged in fit-outs and new construction have their own waste management contracts we can still offer the option of supplying bulk bins to locations that generate significant volumes of waste tiles. I would propose that we use 12m³ Roll on - Roll Off (RORO - See Fig 1 below) bins at these locations for this purpose.

I have attached an example disposal / recycling report for you as well to have a look at.

The Customer must warrant that the waste placed in bins will not contain liquid, hazardous, noxious, dangerous, regulated, radioactive or pathological wastes or substances as defined by applicable laws or regulations unless and except as specifically described in writing by the Customer to SITA Australia with written approval by SITA Australia indicating acceptance of the material and variations.
13. The Customer must not use mechanical means to compact materials into bins and is not to overload (by weight or volume), alter or use the bins in any way other than their proper and intended purpose

15. ** Rental will apply if a minimum of one service / week is not performed at each individual location specified
